Child Passenger Safety Resources for Santa Cruz County



Rear-Facing Seat

California law requires children who are under the age of 2 to ride in the back seat in a rear-facing car seat unless they weigh 40 pounds or more, or are 40" tall or more.

The harness straps should be even with or **below** the shoulders.



Forward-Facing Seat or Booster

Children **under the age of 8** must be buckled into a car seat or booster in the back seat.

Harness straps should be even with or **above** the shoulders.

Children who have outgrown their car seat's 5-point harness by height or weight may be ready for a booster.



No-Cost Car Seats

Car seats are available on a limited basis for lowincome families. Proof of low-income status or a referral from a community agency is required.

Booster Seat

Seat belts don't usually fit until a child is about 4' 9" tall. When your child sits with their back against the back of the seat:

Do their knees bend comfortably over the front of the seat? \square Yes \square No Does the shoulder belt cross the center of their shoulder? \square Yes \square No Does the lap belt touch their thighs? \square Yes \square No

If you answered "no" to any of these questions, your child still needs a booster.
