the following Resolution is hereby adopted:

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CENTRAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF SANTA CRUZ COUNTY, ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF A REPORT MADE BY THE FIRE CHIEF OF THE CENTRAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF SANTA CRUZ COUNTY REGARDING THE INSPECTION OF CERTAIN OCCUPANCIES WHERE THE DISTRICT IS REQUIRED TO PERFORM ANNUAL INSPECTIONS IN SUCH OCCUPANCIES PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 13146.2 AND 13146.3 OF THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE.**

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4 was added in 2018 and became effective on September 27, 2018, and,

WHEREAS, California Health & Safety Code Sections 13145.2 and 13246.3 requires all fire departments, including the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz, that provides fire protection services perform annual inspections in every building used as a public or private school, hotel, motel, lodging house, and certain residential care facilities for compliance with building standards, as provided and,

WHEREAS, California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.2 requires all fire departments, including the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz, that provide fire protection services to report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 and,

WHEREAS, the Board of the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz intends this Resolution to fulfill the requirements of the California Health & Safety Code

regarding acknowledgment of the Central Fire Protection District's compliance with California Health & Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz that said Board expressly acknowledges the measure of compliance of the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz with California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 in the area encompassed by the Central Fire Protection District, as follows:

A. EDUCATIONAL GROUP E OCCUPANCIES:

Educational Group E occupancies are generally those public and private schools, used by more than six persons at any one time for educational purposes through the 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Within the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz, there lie nineteen (19) Group E occupancies, buildings, structures and/or facilities.

During the fiscal year 2019-2020, the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz completed the annual inspection of nineteen (19) Group E occupancies, buildings, structures and/or facilities. This is a compliance rate of 100% for this reporting period.

Additional items of note regarding this compliance rate can be found in the accompanying staff report for this section.

B. RESIDENTIAL GROUP R OCCUPANCIES:

Residential Group R occupancies, for the purposes of this section, are generally those occupancies containing sleeping units, and include hotels, motels, apartments (three units or more), etc. as well as other residential occupancies, including multi-unit licensed residential care facilities. Licensed residential care facilities have a number of different sub classifications, and they may contain clients that require a range of service


or custodial care, due to mobility impairments, cognitive disabilities, etc. The residents may also be designated as non-ambulatory or bedridden.

Within the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz, there lie seventy-four (74) Group R occupancies of this nature. During the fiscal year 2019-2020, the Central Fire Protection District of Santa Cruz completed the annual inspection of 69 Group R occupancies, buildings, structures and /or facilities. This is a compliance rate of 93% for this reporting period.


