RESOLUTION NO. 2022-12**

On motion of Director *Rouco*
Duly seconded by Director *Radliff*
the following Resolution is adopted.

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CENTRAL FIRE DISTRICT APPROPRIATION
LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 UNDER ARTICLE XIII-B OF THE
CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION, AND ESTABLISHING PERIOD FOR
CONTESTING SUCH LIMIT**

WHEREAS Article XIII-B of the California Constitution provides that the state and each local government shall be subject to an annual appropriation limit as defined in that Article; and

WHEREAS Article XIII-B Section 8(e)(2) requires the Governing Body to select the change in Cost-of-Living methodology each year by recorded vote, and

WHEREAS the change in the California per capita personal income provides the greatest result rather than using the local assessment roll from the preceding year; and

WHEREAS, the District has computed the appropriations limit applicable to the District for fiscal year **2022-2023**; and,

WHEREAS the said District is a newly formed District as of February 4th, 2021, which consists of the former Central Fire Protection District and Aptos La/Seiva Protection District,

WHEREAS the computed appropriations limit applicable to the District for fiscal year **2022-2023**, is a sum of the two former District's Appropriation limits, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Central Fire District selects the change in the California per capita personal income and the percentage change within the County area in which the special district is located methodology for use in calculating its appropriation limit for fiscal year **2022-2023**; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the appropriation limit for the Central Fire District for fiscal year **2022-2023** is hereby established as **\$60,793,417** and that such appropriations limit may be adjusted at a later date in accordance with Sections 3 and 11 of Article XIII-B of the California Constitution; and,

No action or proceeding shall be brought, the purpose of which is directly or indirectly to attack, review, set aside, void or annul the appropriations limit established by this resolution unless such action or proceeding shall have been filed and served on the district within forty-five (45) days from the date this resolution is adopted in accordance with Division 9 of the Government Code.


